Our Summer Reading program was a rousing success. We exceeded our goal of 2 million minutes read by over 104,000 minutes! 2,360 community members participated. This is an increase of almost 10% in participants and three times as many minutes read in 2019. Congratulations to both West Muskingum and Bishop Fenwick Elementaries for having the largest number of participants. Both schools will receive a visit from a performer for their prize. This was sponsored by American Pride and Park National Bank. Our Summer Reading Program is our largest program and encompasses all age groups and all MCLS staff working together to make it a success. Participation in a summer reading program is a key indicator of student success in avoiding the summer slide.

We received grants from the Straker Foundation for children's AWE stations at John McIntire, Dresden, and New Concord and from the United Way for a Charlie Cart, which is a mobile kitchen unit to use in programs. Dollar General provided money for our summer reading incentives. We received a grant from the State Library of Ohio for a summer reading performance. Thank you to our community for their continued support!

October 17–22 is National Friends of the Library Week. The Friends of the Library are a dedicated group of volunteers who are committed to focusing attention on the importance of public libraries. 
Top 5 In-Person Checkouts













