Last year's program saw over 2,300 people come together to support our mission, collectively reading an astonishing 2,104,262 minutes in two months!

Research shows that children who don't read over the summer can suffer from the "summer slide" and be up to two years behind their peers in reading skills by the end of 6th grade. By taking part in Summer Reading, students have a much better chance of avoiding this setback and achieving success in the years to come. The program gives you the flexibility to read stories in any format you prefer, including print, ebooks, audiobooks, graphic novels, magazines, and more!

Summer Reading isn't just for teens and kids. Adults are also encouraged to take part in the fun! With great prizes, book clubs and programs, and the satisfaction of completing the Summer Reading Challenge, there's plenty to enjoy.

Remember, Summer Reading is open to everyone, regardless of age, reading style, or ability.
