

The global pandemic has hit home for all of us. The Muskingum County Library System's priorities during the pandemic are the safety and wellness of our team members and access to our services and materials for our community. We know how important access to our libraries is for you and your families. To honor this, we are excited to expand our hours. Starting on

Monday, September 14, we will be open Monday—Thursday from 1–7 PM and Friday from 1–6 PM. As our community works to get back to business and back to school, please know that MCLS is here for you!

Our WiFi is available in our parking lots and green spaces 24/7. We have expanded our hotspot lending program by over 600%. While we cannot have in-person programming, we are working with community partners to provide programming and information via Zoom and our social media accounts.

We've also recently received additional results from Battelle's study on how long the coronavirus can survive on library materials. As a result, we'll quarantine our materials for four days – up from three days before check-in. You'll continue to see delays in the check in of materials, but please know, staff will be working to check in items as soon as the quarantine period is up.

The pandemic has pushed us to offer services in new ways and provided opportunities for us to meet library customers where you are in order to keep us all safe. Whether it be in your car for Curbside Pickup, via telephone or online for Reference Chat, Book an Expert or Techspert, or through Zoom or Social Media Programs. I am proud of the changes to the services our staff has provided in the last four months. We will continue to look for new ways to provide services and to increase access to our libraries as long as we can do it in a way that keeps everyone safe.




