That number seems nearly impossible to fathom, but with only a quick search and a few clicks, you can request items from around the state to arrive at your favorite MCLS location in about a week. Available to all Muskingum County Library System community members, this new collection is a wonderful resource for your educational, recreational, or creative needs. Whether you're a college student searching for a textbook for your class, a family looking for some unique movies for Friday nights, or a romance novel reader seeking that great new book, we can find the right resource for you.






Join us for any or all of our monthly presentation and discussion series with local facilitators on a variety of culture and race-related topics to help understand one another and our cultures. Registration required.
