The J.W. and M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation supports life-enhancing projects in Muskingum County. Literacy, love of reading, and good writing were important to my mother, Mary Helen Straker; we are pleased to partner with the Muskingum County Library System on 2023's CommUNITYread selection: *A Princess Found* by Sarah Culberson.

The Foundation invites community members to Secrest Auditorium at 9:30 AM on March 23. Ms. Culberson—Princess Sarah—will speak and help distribute \$500 prizes to school winners of our second Mary Helen Straker Award in Writing. This year, the competition is open to high school juniors and sophomores in Muskingum County. Princess Sarah will announce the \$2,000 grand prize winner.

Although she struggled with identity as a bi-racial girl in a mostly white community, Sarah had a happy childhood in a loving adoptive home. Before connecting with her birth father, Sarah graduated from West Virginia University, earned an MFA in San Francisco, and started a career in education and entertainment in Los Angeles.

When Sarah made the commitment to find her father, things happened quickly. Soon she was on the phone with her uncle, who said, "Sarah, do you know who you are? You are a princess!" That revelation led her to Sierra Leone and her birth father, Joseph Kposowa; with her half-brother, Sarah started a foundation to benefit the people of Sierra Leone.
