Get ready to add some color to your summer by joining the Muskingum County Library System's Summer Reading Program! This year's theme is **Color Our World** and will run from June 1 through July 31. This program is open to **all ages**, allowing families and friends to enjoy the program together! All you have to do is sign up at your nearest MCLS location or online through our website, read a little every day, and track your progress using the Beanstack app or paper tracker. Last year, we had 2,628 people participate in Summer Reading. We truly hope that you'll consider participating in this year's program and help us reach 3,000!

Reading daily helps kids retain skills learned during the school year and helps reduce the "summer slide." The program boosts literacy skills like vocabulary, comprehension, spelling, and grammar while also encouraging critical thinking and knowledge building. As you log your reading, you'll earn points toward milestone prizes and tickets for a chance to win some of our awesome grand prizes like a Nintendo Switch Lite, a scooter, a Riesbeck's gift card, and even a Wilds Zipline Safari Tour for two! We will also be offering an array of in-person programs all summer long at all of our branch locations and throughout the community.





